ROUNDTRIP





The National Tourist Routes were an initiative set up by the Norwegian Public Roads. Administration to identify the Norway's key scenic roads and pepper them with spectacular architectural pit stops. More than 50 architects, landscape architects, designers and artists has been engaged to facilitate the experience of nature, while also appearing as an attraction in its own right. The drive along the Ryfylke National Tourist Route is a trip full of contrasts. Here you will encounter high barren mountains, lush hillsides, sheer

mountainsides and deep fjords.

ALMANNAJUVET

The Allmannajuvet zinc mines are a disused mining works in Sauda. The mines were in operation from 1881 to 1899. Today, the mining area is a museum. The plain buildings in the gorge are designed in an industrial construction style to embody the story of the mines.

HØSE BRIDGE

Høse bridge lies in the village of Sand, the administration centre of Suldal municipality. Suldal is a large producer of hydroelectric power, and rural tourism, mining and aguaculture provide supplementary industries. Høse bridge is a footbridge over the Suldalslågen river. It lights up beautifully on dark autumn and winter nights and leads to the recreational area across the river.

SVANDALSFOSSEN

The Svandalsfossen waterfall is a mighty spectacle when the river runs high. The 540 steps bring visitors into close proximity with the powerful waterfall and the lush, magical vegetation that characterises the area.



SALMON FARM AND AQUACULTURE CENTRE AT RØVÆR ISLAND




Røvær island is home to 110 inhabitants and one car. Just a 25 minutes boat ride away from Haugesund. Fish farming is a large and important business along the Norwegian coast, and you can become familiar with this modern industry at the aquaculture centre. You'll also get to know the tiny creatures, seabirds and fish which flourish around Røvær.

The exhibition is compact and provides an easy-to-understand introduction to big and exciting subjects such as aquaculture, history, the environment and natural conditions. Interactive screens provide in-depth information, games and activities. The trip includes visits to a salon farm at sea.


Experience the heart of Haugesund and get a good introduction to this small but vibrant city.

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


THE MUSEUM IN MÆLANDSGÅRDEN

The museum is situated in the old, preserved wooden building in Skudeneshavn.

The museum provides an insight into how the town grew in the 1800s during the rich herring fishery period.

You can see how a middle-class family lived 150 years ago. The museum also contains a shop from 1840, a merchant's house, a dentist's surgery, seahouses and old workshops filled with fishing equipment and boats. There is also a separate thematic exhibition on seafaring and agriculture. Mælandsgården Museum is unique because all of its exhibits have remained in their authentic environment.







This is a unique opportunity to get inside and feel the authentic atmosphere. Hear the history told by enthusiastic locals while tasting their traditional food and drinks. Cherish yesterday, live today and dream for tomorrow together with the married couple Eli and Knut who share their knowledge of the town's history and their joy of an active life in this old historic town.

Guided tour outdoors. Visit the old bakery and brewery rooms. Taste local beers (or soft drinks) and "snacks" while Eli and Knut tell about the history of the house. Come inside the old lace factory "Blondefabrikken" and enjoy a bowl of the very tasty fish chowder made from today's catch and local vegetables. Art exhibitions inside Blondefabrikken will vary between local and internationally known artists.

KRINGSJÅ MOUNTAIN FARM

Close to Haugesund City Centre is an area featuring untouched nature.

THE LANDSCAPE WAS FORMED during the Ice Age thousands of years ago. Here you can find more than a hundred wild sheep. Several paths lead to Kringsjå

Mountain Farm, and the area is open to visitors all year. The Kringsjå cottage is situated only a 15-minute walk away from the best viewpoint in Haugesund - Steinsfjellet Mountain. In bad weather it can be a good idea to get into to the warm cottage, preferably with a cup of coffee or hot chocolate in front of the fireplace. Goats and wild sheep have permanent pasture here. There is also a playground and an outdoor fireplace.





FROM KARMØY TO NEW YORK

Did you know that the copper used in the Statue of Liberty in New York came from Karmøy?

AT THE MINING MUSEUM OF VISNES you can learn about the history of the mining community, which consisted of about 3000 inhabitants in the 1800s. Take a stroll in Director Charles de Franse's elegant garden and view the remains of the old melting works out by the sea. This is an adventure for the children too - the mining playground is very popular. The Visnes Natural History Collection contains birds and animal species native to Karmøy. You can also study the fauna and flora of the area.

RØVÆRHOLMEN LIGHTHOUSE

Røværsholmen Lighthouse, established in 1892, on the west coast of Haugesund. You can reach the island only by boat or by helicopter.



RØVÆR ISLAND



Røvær is an island located 25 minutes off the coast of Haugesund and is home to 110 inhabitants and one car.

ENJOY A FJORD CRUISE between city islands, and out in the open towards the North Sea. A guided tour on the island will give you a glimpse of its history. Follow a marked path which includes a 1000-year old Viking settlement and a museum depicting Røvær's history.

WHITE SANDY **DUNES**

By the North Sea

THIS IS A GREAT HIKE along the nature and heritage trail that runs from the village of Åkra to the village of Ferkingstad. Cultural and historical monuments lie in abundance between Åkra and the boathouse ruins at Hop. The hike starts at the north end of the beach at Åkra. From here you can enjoy the view of the white beaches stretching along the shore. The hike follows a natural path, and along the way you can see and sense a rich fauna and birdlife. At the south end of the beach the tour continues over to a historical area dating back to the Viking Age. Here, you will see stone monuments symbolizing the two daughters of King Augvald, one of our Viking kings. The tour continues to Ferkingstad Beach, where you can have a break and a snack. Afterwards, you can walk to the charming boat harbour, built in the 1960's. The tour finishes at the Fisherman's Memorial, a monument symbolizing local fishermen who lost their lives at sea.

AT RYVARDEN LIGHTHOUSE, the forces of nature will touch both body and soul. The headland seems to reach out and lift you towards where the huge sky meets the mighty sea. Whether the storms rage and you lean into the wind, or the sea is calm, the scenery will give you a breathtaking feeling.

After the lighthouse became automatic in 1984, the buildings have been used as a cultural centre. Here one can find a gallery, café, and museum.

These islands are unique, with narrow canals through beautiful scenery and many idyllic properties. We stop at Røvær to take in the special atmosphere.

FJORD SIGHTSEEING BY BUS OR BOAT TO THE IDYLLIC FJORD VILLAGE NEDSTRAND




SEA FISHING IN THE NORTH SEA




ARQUEBUS MUSEUM






RØLDAL STAVE CHURCH

Røldal stave church, built between year 1200 and 1250, is the most important tourist attraction in the rural parts of $\ensuremath{\mathsf{Roldal}}$. The stave church is one of the most known pilgrim churches and was the second most important pilgrim destination after Nidarosdomen in catholic times. The reason for this is the crucifix, which is still in the church, that according to tales has a healing power every midsummer.








PULPIT ROCK

Preikestolen, also known as the Pulpit Rock or Preacher's Rock, is one of the most popular hiking trips in the region.
