

WALK TO EIGERØY LIGHTHOUSE

ARE YOU READY FOR A TRIP TO THE MOON?

Very few people can travel to the moon, and while the lunar landscape remains a distant dream for most, there exists a place right here on Earth where you can experience a remarkably similar terrain – the Magma UNESCO Global Geopark. The resemblance is especially striking in the vicinity of the Eigergy Lighthouse.

The light part of the moon consist of anorthosite, which is a rare type of rock here on earth, but is common in the Magma UNESCO Global Geopark. It's a geological marvel that brings the allure of the moon's surface much closer to home.

Eigergy Lighthouse is the oldest cast iron lighthou-

se in Norway and one of the most robust lighthouses across Europe. As you embark on this journey, you'll be treated to a delightful exploration of a breathtaking coastal landscape. On clear days, the scenery is nothing short of magnificent, while stormy days add an exciting edge to the experience.

The walk is easy, beloved by locals and travelers alike, combines the joys of simplicity with the wonders of the natural world.

A scenic adventure that invites you to step into a landscape that feels like it's straight out of a lunar dreamscape, yet is found right here on Earth.

- TOUCH objects made of clay at the Faience Museum that tells a story of what was once the town's most important industry.


Tickets to The Fayance Museum and Egersund Chocolate Factory included.

Join this guided walking tour to learn more about current highlights and remarkable history of the lively fishingtown of Egersund.

Egersund town has one of the best preserved wooden housing settlements in Norway.

Another important industry was pottery and faience production, which interestingly led to a colourful palette of wooden house facades. We walk past the Egersund Church dating to 1623. You will also hear the honest (and sweet) story of Egersund Chocoladefabrikk, whose shareholders used to get dividends in chocolate! Taste the raw material and learn how to feel the difference of a quality product.

IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF VIKINGS

JOURNEY 1,000 YEARS BACK IN TIME

Egersund was a notable Viking town due to its unique harbour, where there is no tide. Viking kings moored their ships here and came ashore. The town was once known as Eikundasund.

The tour begins at Hedningholmen, now the site of Egersund Church. In Viking times, a heathen temple likely stood here, where Vikings worshipped Odin and Thor. When Christianity arrived, old religious sites were taken over by Christians. If available, author Arnt Olav Klippenberg, an expert on Vikings, will share stories inside the church.

Klippenberg will guide you to Stoplesteinan, a stone circle known as «Our Stonehenge». This mystical site may have been a thing site, sundial, or place

of worship. The hike takes about 45 minutes round trip.

Next is the heathen temple Rossland, home to a well-preserved altar and sacred symbols of fertility. The walk also takes about 45 minutes.

The final stop is Oddsfjell, named after the saga hero Odd, offering panoramic ocean views and the burial site of Orvar Odd. The hike takes about an hour. During the winter months, we settle for hearing the story at the foot of the mountain.

Klippenberg will narrate the journey through a unique landscape, found only here and on the moon.

Egersund town has one of the best preserved wooden housing settlements in Norway.

As you continue your exploration, you'll discover the enduring legacy of Egersund's pottery and faience production. This thriving industry left behind exquisite ceramic treasures that not only showcase the town's artistic prowess but also played a significant role in shaping the colorful palette of the

town's wooden house facades. Faience, a type of fine tin-glazed earthenware, was skillfully crafted by local artisans, and these beautiful pieces are sought-after collectibles.

Egersund's faience tradition is a testament to the town's artistic heritage. You can still find remnants of this artistry in it's own museum, showcasing the patterns and designs that characterized Egersund's unique faience production.

The influence of this industry on the town's visual identity is undeniable, and it adds a captivating layer to your journey through Egersund's history.

JØSSINGFJORD SCIENCE MUSEUM

AND HOUSES AT HELLEREN

Experience magnificent nature with exciting geology, distinctive culture and WW2 history. On this tour you will be able to witness a connection between human, nature and industry throughout the years.

This tour allows you to experience the magnificence of Norwegian fjords, combined with exciting history related to natural resources of the area. Exciting geology of Jøssingfjord has determined the course of industrial development for decades. Extraction of ilmenite, which is used in many different articles of our everyday life, has been essential.

Helleren is another exciting spot that you would not want to miss.

Tiny cabins from the 1800s in their authentic look right under the massive rock formation raises curiosity in many visitors. Why was this place chosen to live in?

This and many other curiosities and stories from the past that shaped the present you will be able to find at Jøssingfjord Science Museum, which is the newest division of the regional Dalane Folk Museum. This is where nature meets culture, geology and history.

IN THE LAND OF THE TROLLS


Trollpikken, an awe-inspiring stone formation with its unmistakable phallus-shaped silhouette, is an intriguing geological marvel that bears a name that leaves little to the imagination. Trollpikken, directly translates to what you might expect.

The journey to this site begins with a short coach ride from the cruise pier. Once you disembark, a 2.4-kilometer hike awaits, leading you to the world-famous local landmark that has attracted visitors from around the globe.

The unique moonlike landscape you'll encounter on the hike to Trollpikken are more than just visually stunning; they are also steeped in stories

and fun facts, enriching your experience with layers of history and geology. With every step you take, you'll uncover fascinating tales of how these rock formations came to be, offering a window into the geological history of the region. The interplay of forces like erosion, weathering, and the ceaseless march of time has created the landscape that you are now privileged to explore.

Along the way, you'll encounter small streams that meander through the landscape, waterfall with potholes along the road and a rugged rocky terrain.

Enjoy and explore several varieties of beers and their history, and get a little insight to what makes Berentsens one of the leading breweries in Norway.



Berentsens was founded in 1895 by Captain Wilhelm Berentsen as a beverage company. The first distillery was installed in 2018, quickly gaining international recognition with award-winning products.

Sip on a complimentary refreshing beer from their own brewery while listening to a short story about their history, all in the cozy atmosphere of the new Tasting room. After the short story, you'll get to explore the distillery and the Whisky Hall where the casks are stored. On the tour you get an insight into the unique process of making Vardberg Whisky.

The tour concludes in the Tasting room, where you get to sample three unique whiskies.


During the tour, you'll have the opportunity to make 2-3 informative stops along the way.


These stops are enriched with storytelling sessions,


shedding light on the area's cultural and historical significance and the geological wonders that have shaped the breathtaking landscape.


Start your adventure with a guided city walk through Egersund. Spend an hour immersed in the


town's captivating history and flavors.
